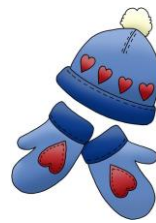
Sharing & Caring:

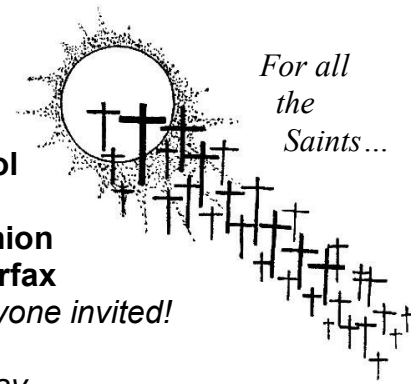
